

Show My Homework Student Guide

Logging into Show My Homework on Desktops

It is recommended that pupils and students use the Google Chrome browser, as this is supported by Show My Homework for Office 365 Single Sign On. Other browsers may return Error 404 pages when logging in.

Step 1: Log into Office 365

On the school website, <https://www.hardenhuish.wilts.sch.uk/>, navigate to the School Portal page and click the Office 365 Login link.

Step 2: SharePoint

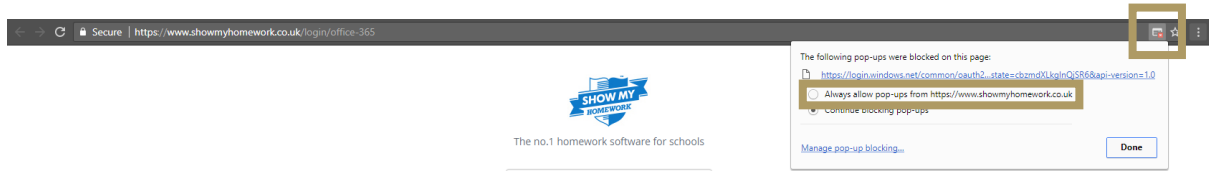
From SharePoint, click the Show My Homework icon.

Logging into Show My Homework on Mobile Devices

A Show My Homework App is available for iOS (iPhone and iPad) and Android devices. This guide shows how to install and use the Android app from an Android phone, but it's possible to install it from any linked Google Account, and the iOS app works the same way.

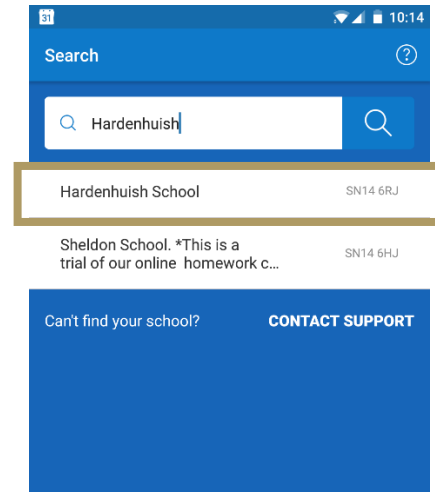
Step 1: Download the App

Search for and download the Show My Homework app (published by Teacher Centric Ltd) from your application store.



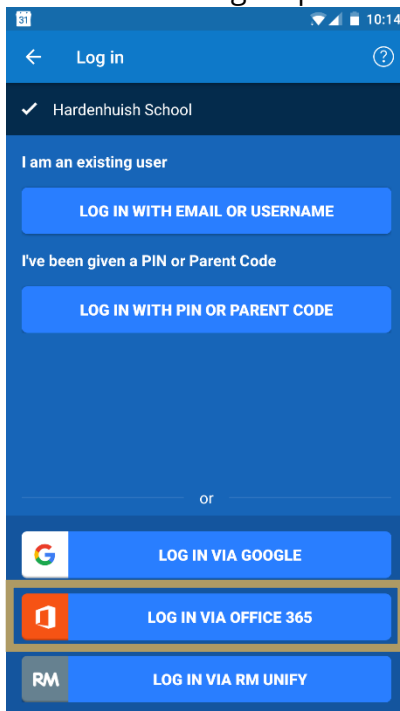
Step 2: Find Hardenhuish School

Open the app and type "Hardenhuish" into the search bar. Tap the search icon and select the Hardenhuish School option.



Step 3: Hardenhuish School page

From the Hardenhuish School page, select the Office 365 login option.



Step 4: Office 365 login

Log in with your school email and password as usual.
