

Year 12 Induction Day

8.15am - 8.30am	Registration All students should register on the school field outside the House. Earlier in the week, students will have been sent an e-mail with their tutor group. On arrival, students should register with their tutor, who will make themselves visible at the top of the field by the House. In the event of wet weather, students will be directed towards the Peter Thompson Hall in E Centre.
8.45am	Tutor Time Tutors will direct students to A centre rooms. Amongst other activities, students will receive a printed copy of their Year 12 timetable.
10.30am	Break Please note that there will not be any food or drink available during the Induction Day and so please bring your own snacks, lunch and refreshments.
10.50am	Option Block A Having received timetables earlier in the day, students will visit each of their subject choices for an introductory lesson. Where students do not have lessons in an option block or are taking a subject at Sheldon, they are encouraged to familiarise themselves with study spaces within A centre.
11.25am	Option Block B Having received timetables earlier in the day, students will visit each of their subject choices for an introductory lesson. Where students do not have lessons in an option block or are taking a subject at Sheldon, they are encouraged to familiarise themselves with study spaces within A centre.
12pm	Option Block C Having received timetables earlier in the day, students will visit each of their subject choices for an introductory lesson. Where students do not have lessons in an option block or are taking a subject at Sheldon, they are encouraged to familiarise themselves with study spaces within A centre.
12.35pm	Lunch Please note that there will not be any food or drink available during the Induction Day and so please bring your own snacks, lunch and refreshments.
1.15pm	Option Block D Having received timetables earlier in the day, students will visit each of their subject choices for an introductory lesson. Where students do not have lessons in an option block or are taking a subject at Sheldon, they are encouraged to familiarise themselves with study spaces within A centre.
1.50pm	Tutor Time At the end of the day, students will return to their tutor group for a short reflection of the day and to receive additional information ahead of starting their timetables on Monday 7 th September.
2.15pm	Finish Students who are new to Hardenhuish are to meet with Mr Wiggall (Deputy Director of Sixth Form) / Mrs Todd (Pastoral Manager for the Sixth Form) in the upper common room.

1. What will I need to bring?

For this Induction Day, all you will need is a pencil case with equipment you would expect to use in your subject along with some blank and lined A4 paper. Your tutor and subject teachers will be able to guide you as to what additional equipment you will need to bring with you to future lessons. If you are new to Hardenhuish and have not already e-mailed a copy of your GCSE results, you will need to bring this with you as well so that it can be uploaded onto our database.

2. What should I wear?
