What work is being set?

- In this third phase, you have been set the following work:
 1. Tell the story of the Grand Alliance using the images supplied as a storyboard
 2. Complete the map activity to see how countries around the world were affected by the Second World War
 3. Country profiles. Dig deeper into finding out about Vietnam and Korea in terms of their roles during the Second World War

How long should I spend on this work?

- It is expected that you spend around 2.5 to 3 hours on this first phase of work.
