TASK 2: Tectonic processes and hazards

Please research a tectonic hazard event of your choice which has taken place in the last 2 years (Volcano, Earthquake, Tsunami).

The event can be from anywhere in the world.

Use your information to put together a report about the event. Your report must include:

- *At least 2 sides of A4 - However, you can use any method of presentation you wish. This can include hand-drawn, however you will need to take a photo to upload/submit the work.*
- *Location Description*
- *Causes of the event*
- *Impacts- Consider SEE- This could be done in a table if you wanted to.*
- *Management of the event*
- *Any additional information such as pictures, maps etc. to supplement your writing.*
- *At the end of the report, please also provide a list of sources showing where you gathered your information.*
- ***Please avoid copying and pasting chunks of text- this is plagiarism. Instead it would be good to see the report written using a variety of sources and in your own words.***

- Please upload your report to the folder on Teams Assignments. You will need to upload the document e.g. word document, publisher or ppt document. If you have completed your work by hand, then you will need to take a photo of your work or scan it to the computer and upload it into the assignments folder.
