Your Phase 3 work:

Investigating your local area and the sense of place

Over the summer, investigate the local area in which you live. This may be Chippenham, Calne, Corsham, Melksham, a local village, or even further afield. Put together a piece about your area of **no more than two sides of A4**. However, alike Phase 1 and 2, you can present this in any way you wish.

You will need to research your location online, as well as getting out and about to take some photos and even to speak with local people. **However, depending on restrictions, make sure to take care with any primary data collection you do.**

In your research you will need to consider the following questions:

- Location- Where is it? What other places are nearby?
- Is it a village, town, suburb, part of a city etc.?
- What types of buildings can we find and what are they used for?
- What different types of land-use can we find?
- Are there any green spaces and what are they used for?
- Who lives here and what do they do?
- How do people use this landscape in different ways?
- Are there any local 'landmarks'?
- What types of transport links can we find?
- What evidence is there of connections to other places?
- What was this place like in the past?
- How and why is it changing?

Try to be creative in the way you present your work e.g. consider showing some of the above elements through annotated photos or maps.
