

## **Y7 DofE Do It 4 Youth Challenge**



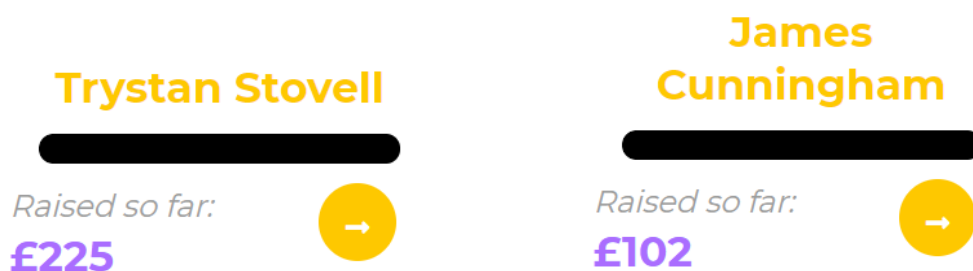
