


Parent Meetings in the School 2022-23 - Parent Survey Feedback

Thank you to all the parents who completed our recent survey regarding whether you would prefer Parent and Pupil/Student Consultation Evenings and Parent Information, Advice and Guidance Evenings in person at the school or virtually using Microsoft Teams. Parents for 184 pupils and students completed the survey and your responses have helped us to plan for next year.

We have summarised the results for you below. As you can see, a large majority have stated that they prefer that meetings are virtual. However, there were a number of parents who expressed they would like more opportunities to come in to school and meet staff face to face, especially if new to the school. We have, therefore, come up with a plan that we hope will take all preferences into account.



Our Plans For Next Year

- ⇒ All PPCE, PSCEs and Parent/Tutor Evenings to remain on Microsoft Teams.
 - Should a parent require a longer appointment with a member of staff to discuss a particular issue, please arrange to come in to meet at the school at a mutually convenient time.
- ⇒ Most of our PIAGs will remain on Microsoft Teams but a number of them will be hosted in the school (with recordings of them made available for those who can't make it) as follows:
 - The first Y7 PIAG (6th October 2022)
 - Whole School PIAGs focussing on Mental Health and Community Safety (16th November 2022 and February 2nd 2023 respectively).
 - 6th Form Open Evening (1st December 2022)
 - Y9 Options Evening (19th January 2023)

In addition, parents who want to get more involved in the wider life of the school or who want to more regularly meet staff to ask questions are encouraged to take part in the Friends of Hardenhuish, which will be re-launched in the new school year.

We also look forward to seeing parents in person at the many school events and performances that will occur throughout the year.
