### What is Sixth Form like?

# What makes Hardenhuish unique?

- Continued 3 way relationship between school/student/home.
- The best of both worlds: a very different experience for the students to the main school but continuity of provision at the same time.

**Entry Requirements** 

- ✓ Enrolment in the Sixth Form is subject to achieving the minimum entry requirements of two GCSE grade 4s and three GCSE grade 5s, including at least a grade 4 in English Language or Literature and at least a grade 4 in Mathematics.
- ✓ In addition, there may be subject specific entry requirements and/or the need to have studied the subject at GCSE Level (please see the prospectus)









# **Apprenticeship** level

Advanced	3	2 A Levels / Level 3 diploma / international Baccalaureate
Higher	4,5,6 & 7	Foundation degree and above
Degree	6 & 7	Bachelor's or master's degree

## **College Courses**

### Diplomas and T-levels

- Work related/ vocational qualifications
- Courses at Level 1, 2 and 3
- One and two year courses/ progress through levels
- Usually one 'subject' chosen
- Assessed through both coursework and exams
- Work experience and links with industry
- Core industry related units plus options, shaping the emphasis of the qualification
- Level 3 Extended Diplomas and T-levels are equivalent to 3 A-levels and progression to University


