Course overview

GCSE Statistics - Exam board - Pearson Edexcel

Two exams at the end of Year 10:

- Weds the 5th June (Afternoon)
- Mon 17th June (Afternoon)

Both papers are 1h 30 minutes and out of 80 marks. A **Calculator** is required for both papers.

Tier of Entry

Higher: Grades 9 – 4

Foundation: Grades 5 - 1

We review tier of entries on a regular basis, so that pupils are entered for the most appropriate exam.

3) Ask teachers for help.


Equipment

- Geometry sets are also needed when pupils are asked to measure angles or construct diagrams with a compass.




