Our curriculum is focussed on enabling our pupils to grow, mature and flourish from those early roots in a safe and sustainable environment. We instil habits in the pupils through our Successful Lives programme, that will serve them well for the rest of their lives, including creativity, confidence and resilience to embrace challenge and change. This programme helps the pupils to not only understand how to learn but develops their skills for life and provides the foundations for a lifelong desire to learn.

In order to ensure a seamless transition from primary school, our Year 7 Learning Manager visits prospective pupils in their primary schools, and gives very careful consideration to every child when placing them into tutor groups. The induction continues with a highly successful team building experience at the start of Year 7. This enables exploration and reinforcement of new relationships with other tutees as well as with the Tutor and the year group's Pastoral Manager, who will both remain with the pupils, providing continuity as they progress through to Year 11.

Every year group at Hardenhuish has a non-teaching Pastoral Manager, available throughout the day to pupils and parents. The Pastoral Manager and Tutor are key points of contact for parents. We also offer other opportunities for parental engagement: specific year group information evenings, pupil and parents consultation evenings as well as the Friends of Hardenhuish parents' association.

We are consistently amongst the top performing non-selective schools in Wiltshire and nationally, with a large proportion of our students progressing to top universities. Our rigorous recruitment and training programmes, as well as collaboration with other schools and universities, ensure that we attract the best staff to support our pupils and that their knowledge and expertise remain at the leading edge of education.**

Success is not just academic. High achievement is recognised wherever it occurs – on the sports field, in a music concert, drama or dance performance, at a public speaking event.

We have a broad and balanced curriculum offer that is designed to provide a holistic experience for all pupils at every key stage. We have the full suite of subjects on offer and provide an element of choice from Year 9 onwards. ## Branching Out...

At Hardenhuish School we develop the whole person by offering a wide range of experiences in addition to the core curriculum. These include our popular Successful Lives days when pupils are involved in team experiences such as the immensely enjoyable and enterprising Smoothie Day, STEM or the thought provoking World War I Day.

Throughout the year there are extensive opportunities for pupils to explore existing interests and try new ones both at lunchtime and after school: for example, musical groups, sports, chess, creative writing, trips to art galleries, theatres, and many more. Our very successful Activities Day, which allow pupils to take part in a range of different activities and trips, ensure that each year finishes on a high note.



Pupils are encouraged to branch out and try new things as part of their growth and development. We offer many international experiences such as language learning and skiing trips to Europe, and even further afield, geography and enrichment trips to other continents.

Pupil voice sits at the heart of the school. Our sixth form Student Leadership Team drives forward leadership across the school, including leading our School Parliament, with representatives from each year group. This pupil group is involved in many aspects of school life and influences policy in such areas as uniform and catering, as well as making decisions on the annual school charity and organising school fundraising events.

# The sky is the limit

## Fully grown and moving on...

**Throughout their formative years we provide regular independent advice and guidance to all pupils at the school, enabling them to make post 16 decisions which offer the best option for them as an individual. Hardenhuish offers a wide range of A Level courses and most pupils choose to continue their education in the Hardenhuish Sixth Form, which has its own purpose-built centre and has been consistently judged one of the most successful in Wiltshire.**

The Sixth Form team, comprising a Director and Deputy Director, two part time Pastoral Managers, Careers Lead and Core and Enrichment Lead, are committed to the full time care and support of our sixth formers. They assist students with their post 16 choices to ensure that they are able to pursue their chosen future direction. Students from Hardenhuish progress to a wide variety of courses at universities, including Oxbridge and top Russell Group universities, as well as specialist colleges. Some students prefer to start their career after sixth form

and we assist them in finding suitable management training programmes or advanced apprenticeships.

Year 12 and 13 students are fully integrated into the school, many offering mentoring to our younger pupils whilst others offer service to the local community.

We strive for all young people to leave us as well rounded citizens who are independent, confident, lifelong learners, continuing to grow and branch out into all areas of 21st century life.
