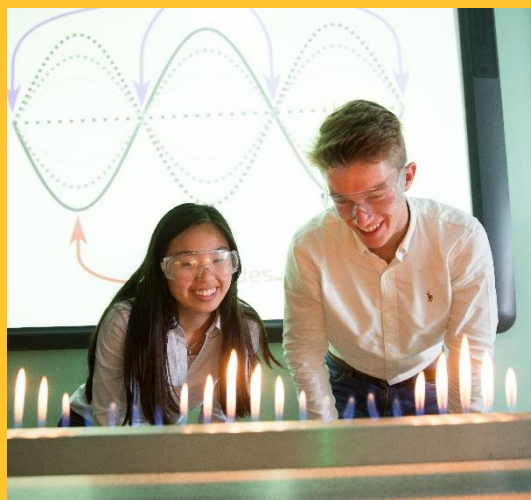

# What is Hardenhuish Sixth Form like?

- ✓ In addition, there may be subject specific entry requirements and/or the need to have studied the subject at GCSE Level (please see the prospectus).

#### **Park & Ride Services**

Regular park and ride services from Lansdown (BA1 9BJ), Newbridge (BA1 3NB) or Odd Down (BA2 2SL). Services run every 15-20 minutes into the city centre, the college is within easy walking distance of drop off points.

#### **By Train**

Bath Spa Railway station is within easy walking distance of our City Centre Campus. Bath Spa is a mainline station with regular services from Bristol, Somerset and Wiltshire areas. National Rail enquiries will give you more information on times of trains and fares.



Students aged 16 and 17 are eligible to apply for a 16-17 railsaver card, costing £35 per year. This will give you 50% discount on the cost of an adult ticket. Students aged 18 and over can purchase a railcard for £35 per year, saving you 1/3 on the cost of an adult ticket. Low-income families may be eligible for help towards the cost of travel through our bursary system.
