- 2 exams at the end of Year 10 which require a calculator.
- Both exam are out of 80 marks and will be completed in 90 minutes

- Paper 2 = Friday 12th June (PM)




Preparation

 [Sparx Homework will not be set during the mocks or during the GCSE Statistics Exams]






Sparx Maths


