Courses are free for learners who meet our eligibility criteria

You must be aged 19 years old or over on 31 August 2025, live at a Wiltshire postcode, and meet residency requirements.

In addition, you need to meet **at least one** of the following criteria:

- Individual income less than £25,750 per year
- In receipt of benefits (excluding child benefit)
- Be a foster carer or carer
- Be a care leaver
- Be part of a military family or be ex-armed forces personnel
- Have refugee or asylum seeker status
- Have a learning difficulty or disability
- Be looking to move into work, now or in the future
