

Year 7 – End of Year Review

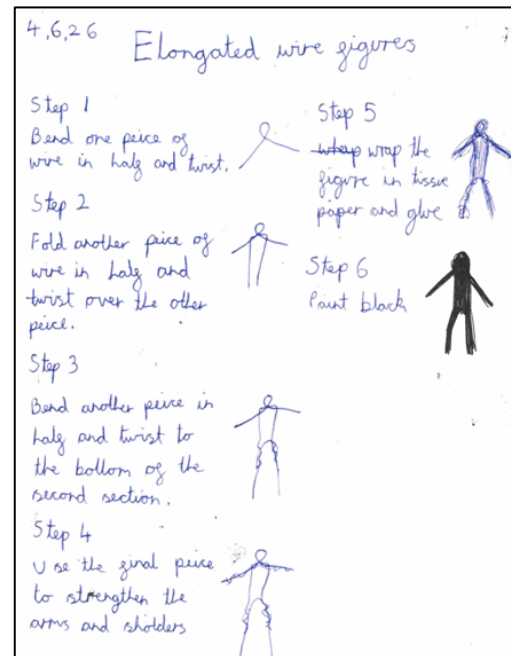
Year 7 have produced amazing work this year using a wide range of skills and materials.

I really enjoyed learning about Giacometti because it was fun making the statues and trying to give them personality.'

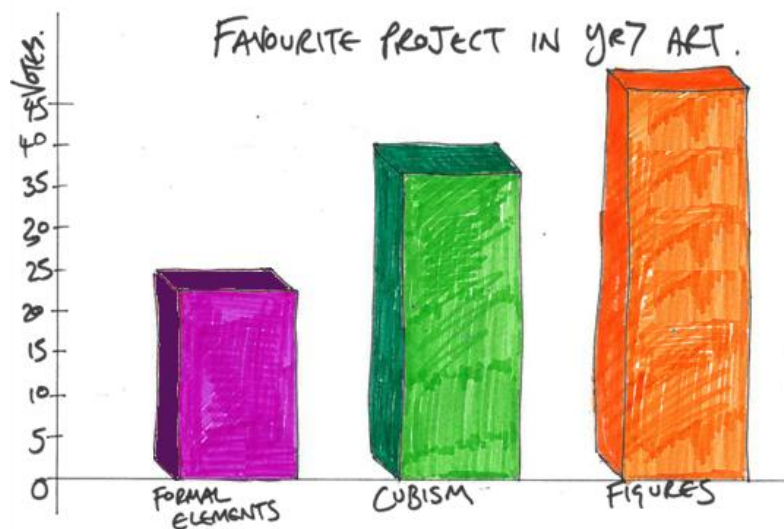

Formal Elements = 22 votes

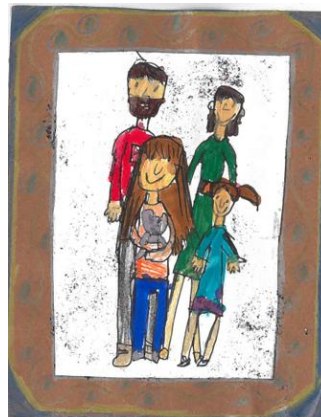
Cubism = 37 votes
